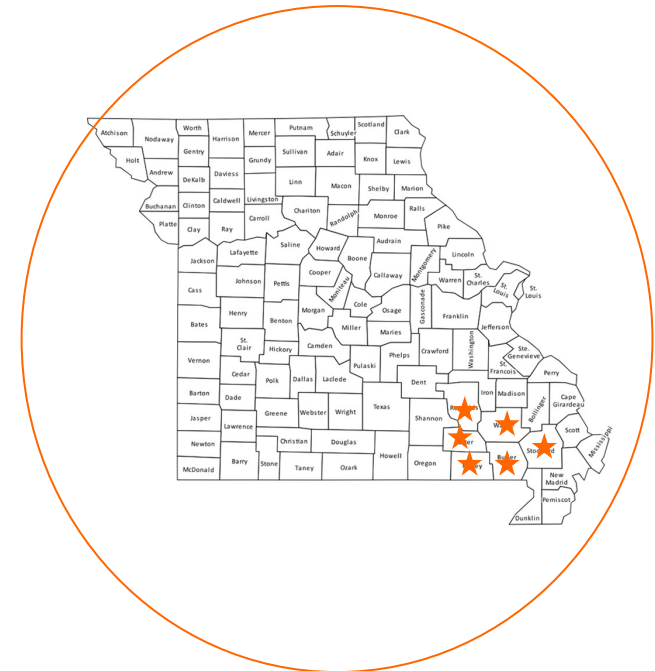

## Prevention Resource Center (PRC)

The Division of Behavioral Health has designated Southeast Missouri Behavioral Health in Poplar Bluff as a Prevention Resource Center (PRC). Southeast Missouri Behavioral Health provides prevention services for Service Area 19 which includes the following six counties:
